

## Water Me Everyday

Anaqua - Desert Willow - Italian Cypress

Magnolia - Mesquite - Norfolk Pine - Palms - Pecan

Possum Haw - Red Bud - Texas Mt. Laurel

Vitex - Wax Myrtle - Wild Olive

If planted in spring or summer, water every day for 2 weeks, then 3x a week for 1 month, then 2x a week for 1 month, then once a week through the following summer.

If planted in the fall or winter, water every day for 1 week, then 3x a week for 1 month, then 2x a week for 1 month, then once a week through the next summer.

Only count rain as 1 watering. Water the next scheduled day even if you have to wade through water.

Lawn sprinkler systems do not provide adequate water for new trees; apply 5 to 10 gallons of water by hose or bucket per tree, per watering through the first 3 months. We recommend marking sprinkler heads, sprinkler lines, and communication cables to avoid damage. (Call 811 to locate utilities)
